

Embedding Maths in a Health & Social Care Level 2 Course

Funding Guidance

FUNDING OVERVIEW

Local Areas or Providers that sign up to a Multiply Education Research Trial are eligible to receive funding based on the number of learners and the number of additional guided learning hours per trial. All Local Areas or Providers will be allocated to the trial treatment group and will receive funding, as outlined below.

FUNDING ALLOCATION

Treatment group	Admin premium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 10% premium of the <u>planned</u> learner numbers (based on intervention costs) to support learner recruitment, submission of trial data, trial training and travel expenses.
	Intervention costs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> £7.20 per additional guided learning hour (GLH) based on <u>recruited</u> number of learners to support delivery of the intervention Plus, area cost and disadvantage cost uplifts will be added, as applicable.
	Additional benefits	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Providers will receive a £1000 one off payment. Teachers will receive free, high-quality training on how to implement the lessons.

FUNDING REQUIREMENTS

Local Areas or Providers must fulfil certain requirements to be eligible to receive funding, including

- Grants signed by the trial deadline
- Meet agreed milestones, as set out in the grant
- Submit invoices in line with the payment schedule

WHEN IS FUNDING PAID?

Providers will receive funding in three payments. The payment dates will vary per trail.

Treatment group	First payment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 10% premium of the planned learner numbers (based on intervention costs) • 50% of the total Intervention cost, based on submitted planned learner numbers • Plus, one off payment of £1000 per provider • The first payment can be claimed up front, before the trial begins
	Second payment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 30% of the total Intervention cost, based on actual recruited learner numbers • The second payment can be claimed after the first payments activities are completed in advance of the second activities
	Final payment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 20% of the total Intervention cost, based on actual recruited learner numbers • The final payment can be claimed after the second payments activities are completed in advance of the final activities

	<p>50% Intervention costs</p> <p>Calculation: (Cost per learner x additional learning hours x planned learner number) x 50%</p> <p>$(£7.20 \times 18 \times 15) \times 50\% = £972$</p> <p>The area cost and disadvantage cost uplift will be added as applicable.</p>
	<p>£1000 one off payment to providers</p>
Second payment	<p>30% Intervention costs</p> <p>Calculation: (Cost per learner x additional learning hours x recruited learner number) x 30%</p> <p>$(£7.20 \times 18 \times 13) \times 30\% = £505.44$</p> <p>Funding will be adjusted for any overpayment or underpayment in the first payment.</p> <p>The area cost and disadvantage cost uplift will be added as applicable.</p>

Final payment	<p>20% Intervention costs</p> <p>Calculation: (Cost per learner x additional learning hours x recruited learner number) x 20%</p> <p>(£7.20 x 18 x 13) x 20% = £336.96</p> <p>Funding will be adjusted for any overpayment or underpayment in the first two payments.</p> <p>The area cost and disadvantage cost uplift will also be added as applicable.</p>
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FAQs

1. Can I take part in more than one trial?

Yes, we welcome expressions of interest to participate in more than one trial. There are perks of being involved in more than, including financial remuneration.

2. Can I claim AEB funding and Multiply Education Research Trials intervention funding?

Yes, if allocated to the intervention group, you can claim 12 additional GLH per learner to recognise providers are delivering additional learning.
