# **Funding Guidance**

#### FUNDING OVERVIEW

Local Areas or Providers that sign up to a Multiply Education Research Trial are eligible to receive funding based on the number of learners and the number of additional guided learning hours per trial. All Local Areas or Providers will be allocated to-the trial treatment group and will receive funding, as outlined below.

Treatment group	Admin premium Intervention costs	<ul> <li>10% premium of the <u>planned</u> learner numbers (based on intervention costs) to support learner recruitment, submission of trial data, trial training and travel expenses.</li> <li>£7.20 per additional guided learning hour (GLH) based on <u>recruited</u> number of learners to support delivery of the intervention</li> <li>Plus, area cost and disadvantage cost uplifts will be added, as applicable.</li> </ul>
	Additional benefits	<ul> <li>Providers will receive a £1000 one off payment.</li> <li>Teachers will receive free, high-quality training on how to implement the lessons.</li> </ul>

## **FUNDING ALLOCATION**

## FUNDING REQUIREMENTS

Local Areas or Providers must fulfil certain requirements to be eligible to receive funding, including

- Grants signed by the trial deadline
- Meet agreed milestones, as set out in the grant
- Submit invoices in line with the payment schedule

## WHEN IS FUNDING PAID?













Providers will receive funding in three payments. The payment dates will vary per trail.

Treatment group	First payment	<ul> <li>10% premium of the planned learner numbers (based on intervention costs)</li> <li>50% of the total Intervention cost, based on submitted planned learner numbers</li> <li>Plus, one off payment of £1000 per provider</li> <li>The first payment can be claimed up front, before the trial begins</li> </ul>
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	Second payment	<ul> <li>30% of the total Intervention cost, based on actual recruited learner numbers</li> <li>The second payment can be claimed after the first payments activities are completed in advance of the second activities</li> </ul>
	Final payment	<ul> <li>20% of the total Intervention cost, based on actual recruited learner numbers</li> <li>The final payment can be claimed after the second payments activities are completed in advance of the final activities</li> </ul>
